1. The Embassy of India, Moscow invites bids from interested contractors for repair/painting of flat No. 156, Korpus No. 1 at Kutuzovsky Prospect-7/4, Moscow (Russian Federation).

2. The work description is as follows:

(a) Scraping, repair and painting of walls including ceilings in drawing room, bed rooms and corridor.

(b) Removal of floor covering and laying of laminate sheets in the rooms, wherever damaged.

(c) Cleaning and polishing of wooden floor in all rooms.

(d) Painting of doors and windows. Repair/ replacement of unserviceable electric points/ switches and replacement of unserviceable bulbs.

(e) Minor repairs of wooden fittings, if any.

3. Schedule of payment for the work will be as follows:-

(a) Mobilization advance of 30% of the total value to be paid within 3 days of the signing of the contract. The contractor will be required to furnish bank guarantee for the same amount.

(b) Second installment of 20% of the total value on commencement of the work.

(c) Third installment of 50% of the total value of the work to be paid on completion of the work to the satisfaction of the Embassy of India.

(d) Any delay in the completion of work beyond the agreed duration would lead to deduction in payment @ 1% of total value of contract per day of delay.

4. Interested parties may visit the site and measure the area or scope of work for formulating their quotation from 12.09.2020 to 03.10.2020. Prior appointment should be made with Air Wing of the Embassy of India (Tel. No. 495-7837535 /Extn 254) for this purpose.

5. Contractors are required to submit their bids in two separate sealed envelopes as follows:-

(a) The first envelope should be marked "Technical Bid" and should contain the technical description of the work, material used, methodology and duration of the work.

(b) The second envelope should be marked "Financial Bid" and should contain the total cost of work, along with detailed breakup of costs.

(c) It may be noted that the quotation should be valid for a period of six months.

6. Both the sealed envelopes should be submitted to Air Wing, Embassy of India, Moscow latest by 03/10/2020 before 1400 hrs accompanied with the proof of payment of Rbls 30,000/- to the Embassy of India, Moscow vide bank transfer (Bank details can be obtained from the Embassy while visiting the site for inspection). The amount of Rbls. 30,000/- will be treated as earnest money and would be returned to all the unsuccessful bidders within three working days of the opening of the bid.

7. Representatives of all the bidding parties can be present at the time of the opening of the bids. The technical bids will be opened on 03/10/2020 at 1700 hrs at the Embassy of India, Moscow, Vorontsovo Pole, 6-8. After the examination of the technical bids by the Tendering Committee of the Embassy, the financial bids of only those parties will be opened whose technical bids are found acceptable by the Tendering Committee. The financial bids will be opened at 1730hrs and the same day, work will be offered to the lowest bidding party.
